Noipack Oy declares that the article meets the requirements of:

Area of use

Based on the migration tests and Declaration of Compliance in Noipack's possession, the articles can be used safely with all types of foodstuffs, serving cold and hot.

The articles are intended to be used for short term storage, 2 hours at temperatures up to 70°C. Items are also possible to be used for hotfill*.

Due to the material properties, the item performs the best with dry foods. There is no any limitation in using the item for moisty or fatty foods but it may effect the behavior of the cardboard. Grease and moist will leave stains on the material.

The articles cannot be used in the microwave.

*Definition from COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) 2016/1416: "hot-fill" means the filling of any article with a food with a temperature not exceeding 100 °C at the moment of filling, after which the food cools down to 50 °C or below within 60 minutes, or to 30 °C or below within 150 minutes.

No PFAS (Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) are intentionally added.

Please be advised that Noipack Oy does not add anything into the product.
