Declaration of Compliance

This is to certify that all the products delivered by Siluett of Sweden AB are approved for use in direct contact with food according to the following organisations, regulations and standards:

REACH.

(European Regulation for Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals)

In accordance with the guidelines of the REACH Regulation (n. 1907/2006), all manufactures or importers of chemical substances from outside the UE Countries, in a quantity of 1 ton or more per year, have to register them with the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) with modalities and time subject to the quantity produced/imported and how hazardous the substances are.

Our company is a manufacturer and distributor of articles as defined in Regulation 1907/2006/EC and subsequent updates and amendments, Article 3, paragraph 1, point 3. The articles manufactured and distributed by our company do not fall within the categories described in Article. 7 of the Regulation 1907/2006/EC and subsequent updates and amendments, as the substances included in the articles are not intentionally released during normal and reasonable conditions of use, therefore our company is not subject to the registration of its products.

As downstream user, our company has:

- Asked the suppliers adequate and exhaustive documentation stating the procedure performed to comply with the provisions of Regulation 1907/2006/EC and subsequent updates and amendments, including, first, those relating to the preregistration.
- In accordance with the guidelines of the Regulation, our company has informed and will inform the suppliers about the use of the substances purchased.
- Our company has asked for an update of the Safety Data Sheets in accordance with the requests of attachment II of the REACH.

Finally, we hereby declare, that in our production processes and, according to the information received, in our raw materials and supplier production processes SVHC "Substance of Very High Concern" are not intentionally used in concentration higher than 0.1%, as per art. 57 of the REACH Regulation, as specified by ECHA, the European Chemicals Agency, both in the "Candidate list" of ECHA (candidate substances) and Annex XIV (substances subject to authorization), as updated on 23/01/2024 and 21/01/2025, respectively.

This declaration is effective from the date indicated below and will be substituted in case considerable changes in the production of the material occur that can alter some essential requirements necessary to obtain the conformity or when the legislations mentioned in this declaration are modified or updated so that a new inspection is required. This declaration is valid for a maximum of twenty-four months.

Traceability

To ensure traceability from the costumer back to our raw materials used in production all finished material has a label or marking with relevant information.

Main purpose: Cooking and presentation of food. Mainly pastries and bakery items.

Products intended for oven use have the following temperature limits: Baking cups are safe for oven use at temperatures up to 220°C. Baking moulds and carton cups are suitable for temperatures between 180°C - 200°C. Glassine cups, cake board and doilies etc. is not for oven use.
